Committee Purpose and Responsibilities:

As condition of possessing a Broad Academic Radioactive Material License, 074-296-1; the North Carolina Regulations for the Protection Against Radiation dictates that a radiation safety committee will provide oversight for all activities involving the use of materials listed on license 074-296-1.

Terms of Office:

Term of office is normally 3-5 years, but members have been reappointed in the past. The Radiation Safety Officer is a permanent member of the committee as well as the “member of management.”
