Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) Advisory Committee (UASAC)

Membership:

Consists of six formal members representing the Office of Research, Economic Development and Engagement, Environmental Health and Safety, Legal Affairs, Insurance, Student Affairs, and the ECU Police Department. There are also two additional committee advisors to the UASAC of representatives from Materials Management and Creative Services.

Committee Purpose and Responsibilities:

The UASAC has a campus safety and compliance focus and reviews applications for exception to the UAS campus-wide ban; prepares approval/disapproval recommendations regarding applications; and provides consultation to university departments on matters related to the use of remotely piloted vehicles and UAS.

Terms of Office:

Indefinite terms of voluntary service for the senior administrator for the offices identified in the membership paragraph above or their respective designees.

To Whom the Committee Reports:

The UASAC is organized and functions in accordance with the provisions and intent of ECU Regulation 01.15.07.

Standard Meeting Time:

At least once per semester and additionally as needed, at the discretion of the chair, based on UAS applications or compliance issues that arise.
